1. Click the sign up link below. If you have already signed up, please move to step 5.

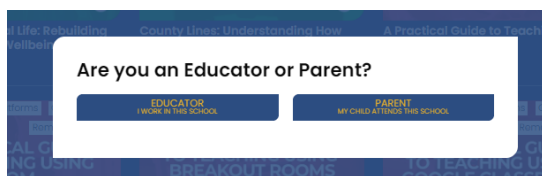

4. You will now have access to all of the resources and courses the NOS offers.

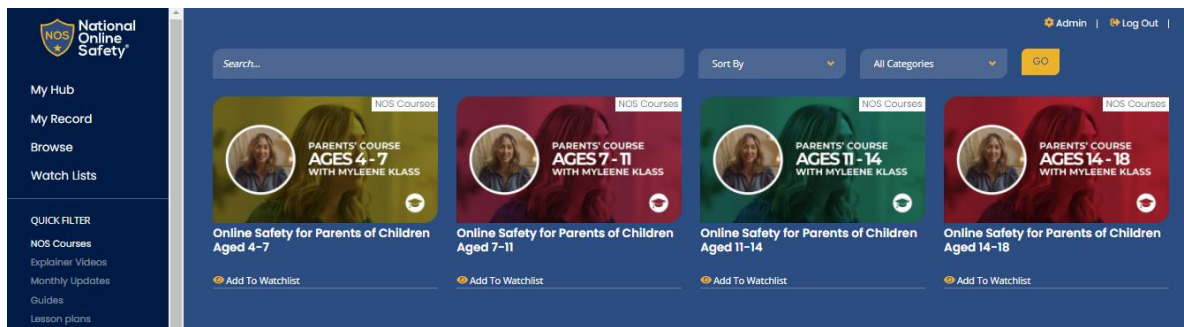
Your Hub and Records are at the top of the side bar. This allows you to see what courses or resources you have accessed as well as a log of your certificates for any courses you have completed.
